DET Scholarships

The Department of Education administers over 200 different student scholarship awards annually.

Applications for a range of scholarships open Sunday 1 October 2023 and close 11.59pm on Thursday, 1 February 2024

Scholarships are available to students who complete Years 4 to 12 in 2023.

Students must apply for a scholarship for the year level they undertook in 2023, e.g. a student in Year 8 in 2023 would apply for a Year 8 scholarship.

These school scholarships are for students who are studying in Victorian schools (Australia) and who are citizens or permanent residents of Australia.


