Student Survey

Our school is conducting a survey to find out what your child thinks of our school. The Attitudes to School survey is an annual student survey offered by the Department of Education and Training. The survey assists schools in gaining an understanding of students' perceptions and experience of school. Our school will use the survey results to plan programs and activities to improve your child's schooling experience.

A letter outlining this survey will be sent home shortly. The survey only takes 20-30 minutes to complete and occurs during your child's class time. Students from Kingsbury Primary School- years 4-6 will participate in the survey. Your child will complete the survey online during school hours using a purpose built secure online survey tool.

Bike Education Program

We have been able to secure a Bike Ed program for all Year 3/4/5/6 students, which commenced last term and will continue throughout the next 5 weeks. The school has a number of bikes available for student use, however, any student who is able to bring their own bike, please do so. Remember, safety gear, such as helmets are essential. This program is free to all students in these year levels and is funded by the School Sporting Program.
