Department of Education Attendance Requirements



From Term 2 last year, all Victorian government schools are required to contact parents/carers as soon as practicable on the same day of an unexplained student absence. If your child is absent on a particular day and you have not contacted the school to explain why, the absence will be marked as unexplained. If your child is sick or absent, you are required to notify the school **by 9.30am on the day of absence, by calling the school office on 9462 2711, emailing kingsbury.ps@edumail.vic.gov.au or by downloading our app "Flexibuzz" from the App Store (free to download, simply subscribe to our school).** Notifying the school of your child's absence either prior to, or on the day that they will be away, helps ensure the safety and wellbeing of children and will fulfil your legal responsibility. This system also promotes daily school attendance. Going to school every day is the single most important part of your child's education, they learn new things every day – missing school puts them behind. The Kingsbury Primary School's Attendance Policy which outlines the school's processes and procedures for monitoring, recording and following-up of student absences is available from the school office. ***Please remember that it is your responsibility to notify the school if your child is going to be late or away from school.***

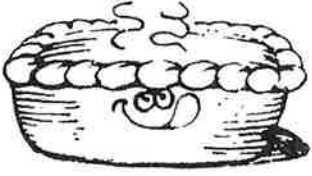

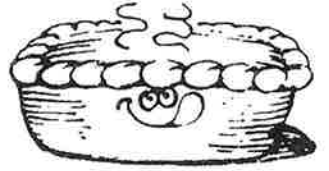
