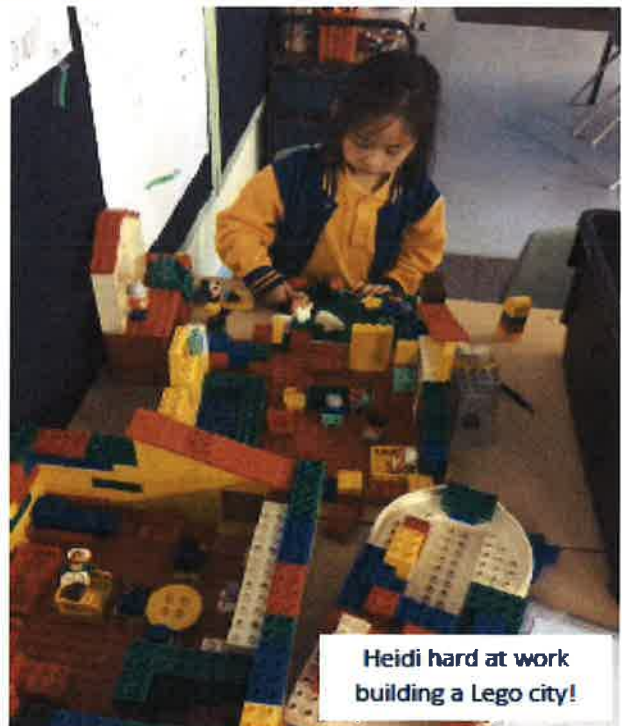
## KINGSBURY OUT OF SCHOOL HOURS CARE

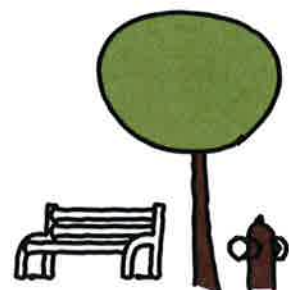
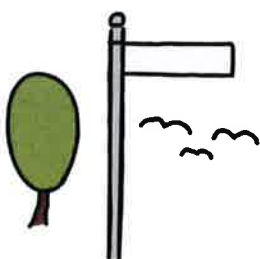

## TEDDY BEARS PICNIC

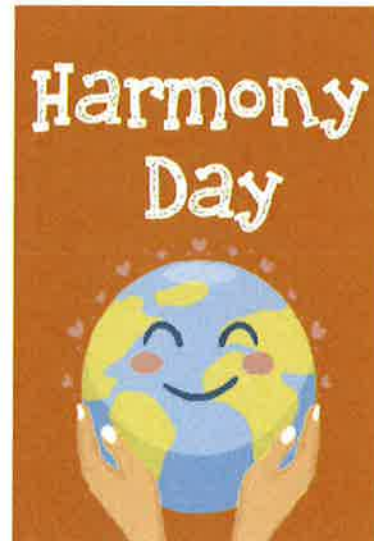
Last Thursday saw our Foundation (Prep) students taking part in "The Teddy Bear Picnic", in our Sensory Garden.
